At first, your child will probably just memorize the poem, but our goal is that as we introduce more sight words and teach reading strategies, he/she will apply them to our poem reading!

In math we have started all 8 math tubs! Math tubs are a time for your child to practice the skills we have learned the previous weeks through games and manipulatives. For example, last week our focus was shapes, so this week we have several tubs full of shape games and manipulatives for your child to build shapes. As we move through the year, we will continue to rotate games and skills according to student needs and the weekly focus!
