What we have been learning:

Reading: We have been learning main idea. We are learning the popcorn words but, not, by. Our poem this week was <u>Hibernation</u>. If your child has mastered letters and sounds, move on to first sound fluency (Example "What is the first sound in the word Cat?" /C/). If your child can get 30 or more first sounds in 1 minute, practice Phoneme Segmentation (Example "Tell me all the sounds in the word dog" /d/ /o/ /g/).

Math: In math we are counting to 80, reviewing counting, matching, and writing numbers 0-20, patterns, making ten, and addition facts to 10. Our main focus for this week was place value. No Envision topic.

Writing: We have been writing sentences this week! I have seen huge improvements in student writing over the past couple of weeks!! Keep encouraging your student to use popcorn words in their writing and to sound out the words that they do not know.
