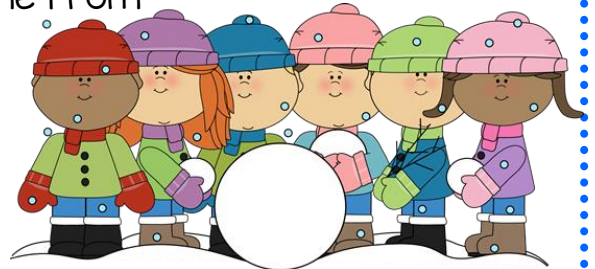


Letters and Sounds
